

SPECIAL RULES OF THE 2008 NAFA 14A NATIONAL TOURNAMENT

This Tournament will be governed by all rules as stated in the 2008 NAFA Rule Book except as noted below as allowed by said Rule Book:

Pool Play:

1. Games will be 1 hour and 45 minutes in length beginning at the conclusion of the pre-game conference. Umpires will record starting time.
2. No new inning will begin after 1 hour and 45 minutes.
3. If the score is tied after the completion of seven innings and before the time limit has expired, additional innings will be played utilizing the Tie Breaker Rule.
4. If after time has expired and the current inning is completed (if necessary) and the score is still tied, the game is over and will be recorded as a "tie game".

Bracket Play:

There will be no time limits in bracket play. However, if tied after the ninth inning additional innings will be played utilizing the Tie Breaker Rule.

Run Ahead Rule:

1. 12 after 4, 10 after 5, 8 after 6.

Coin Flip:

1. A coin flip will determine the home team and the visiting team.

Protests:

1. If there is a protest. The plate umpire will contact the UIC. The UIC and tournament director (Doug Almon and Bob Papich) will rule on the play. Umpire's judgment cannot be protested.
